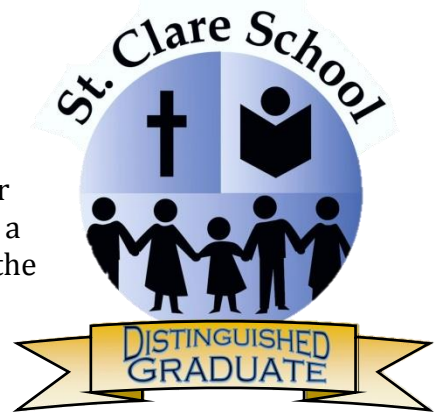


Distinguished Graduate Award 2015
